A Research committee has been set up in 2016-17. The Committee recommends & Approves. Action research topics of the B.Ed 2 years students in the third semester. For the fortification of Research Report writing, workshop is held and Students are guided by the Guide allotted.

#### 6.3.5 Library, ICT and physical infrastructure / instrumentation

Basic facilities such as reference section, daily issues & book bank facility, educational magazines, reading room were provided by the college library to the faculties & students. 'Critical understanding of ICT' is an essential part of the B.Ed syllabus. ICT learning resources are used in laboratory as well as in the classroom well developed computer lab is available.
